Third Placement - Sales and Commercial Manager

For my third placement, I was responsible for account management and sales for a portfolio of large New Zealand customers.

Fourth Placement - Plant Supervisor

For my fourth and final placement, I assumed the role of Boning Room Supervisor working at one of our large multi-species processing sites. In this role I oversaw fulfilment of orders to customer specification, people management, health and safety and food safety. I also spent time shadowing the Production Manager and Plant Manager to gain greater commercial and business understanding.


OUR PROGRAMME FRAMEWORK
