IMPORTANT: We cannot accept and process any bobby calves from your property until this form is completed

- 1. Fully complete the AFFCO Bobby Calf Registration Animal Status Declaration form for each of your properties, checking we have all the correct details. ESPECIALLY YOUR BANK AND GST NUMBERS (IF THEY HAVE CHANGED PLEASE ATTACH A BANK DEPOSIT SLIP AND VERIFICATION OF YOUR GST NUMBER).
- 2. Return it to AFFCO New Zealand Ltd in the freepost envelope provided or scan to lcs@affco.co.nz.

#### **EAR TAG ORDER**





#### Please note:


- AFFCO ear tags are hand applied and do not require additional tools.
- Please check your ear tag delivery bag for your collection schedule and docket book.
- Previous season tags can be used if they have not come from another property.

\*Please note you can use your last season's docket book until completed. Please advise if you require a bag.

#### **CALF PENS**



It is a requirement to have suitable shelter and loading facilities to meet MPI regulations. Please refer to www.mpi.govt.nz/calves

#### **PAYMENT**



- AFFCO will be paying within 7 days, inclusive of kill date.
- Payment notifications are available electronically via email.
   Please ensure you include your email address on the Bobby Calf Registration Animal Status Declaration form.

### CALF ANIMAL WELFARE REQUIRMENTS



Calves must have the following attributes;

- Be more than four days old and not more than two months of age.
- Be fed at least half of their daily ration of colostrum or milk not more than two hours before transport (this is checked as part of the autopsy examination). The stomach must not be concave (sunken).
- The calf is free from signs from any injury, disease, disability, or impairment that could compromise the calf's welfare during the journey\*.
- The calf is alert and able to rise from a lying position, stand and bear weight evenly on all 4 limbs, move freely and protect itself from being trampled and from being injured by other calves\*.
- The calf's hooves are firm, worn flat, and not bulbous with soft unworn tissue; and
- The calf's navel cord is shriveled and not pink or red coloured, raw, or fleshy.

\*This does not apply if the owner or person in charge of the young calf has a veterinary declaration that the calf is fit for transport.

The above welfare requirements are checked by both MPI and the company at each processing plant.

It is important that suppliers communicate with the transport operator to establish the collection time for each property so that the required feeding regime is adhered to.
